

From a sermon published on YouTube on 7/26/19 titled “Finishing Strong” said to be from 2019. It was published by HopeLives365.com the chief of which is Mark Finley.

At about 33:49 you quote Proverbs 15:14 from "Taylor's translation." Are the sheep aware that "Taylor's translation" isn't a "translation" at all but by Kenneth N. Taylor himself is said to be a "paraphrase?" Are the sheep aware that your so called "Taylor's translation" is also known as The Living Bible? Do you consider that so called bible clean provender thoroughly winnowed? Is that bible infallible which means no error at all?

Consider Zechariah 13:6 in The Living Bible that you call "Taylor's translation."

"And if someone asks, 'Then what are these scars on your chest and your back?' he will say, 'I got into a brawl at the home of a friend!'"

In the footnote to that verse it says, "Evidently self-inflicted cuts, as practiced by false prophets." That footnote is exactly the same as the one in my The Catholic Living Bible also by Kenneth N. Taylor that received the "nihil obstat" and the "imprimatur" of the Roman Catholic Church.

Zechariah 13:6 is quoted as follows from the King James Bible on page 226 of The Acts of the Apostles as being one of the prophecies concerning Jesus Christ.

"And one shall say unto him, What are these wounds in thine hands? Then he shall answer, Those with which I was wounded in the house of my friends."

There is another item of interest. You were on the "Project Committee" that was responsible for the publishing of the New King James Version Andrews Study Bible. I've noticed you favor the New King James Version (NKJV) in your preaching. Most editions of the NKJV including the Andrews Study Bible and the Pathfinder edition of the NKJV say the aforementioned wounds were "between" the "arms." The footnote in the Andrews Study Bible for Zechariah 13:6 says, "scars which probably resulted from self-mutilation while participating in idolatrous rituals."

The most charitable view I can take of this is that you in ignorance favor the use of corrupt bibles. An alternate view would be that you do not accept Ellen G. White as an inspired prophet of God. Which is it Mark?
