

“Pr. David Gates – The wise shall understand” was posted on YouTube by RedAdvenir Television on 3/28/20 with David Gates speaking.

At least once before David Gates seemed to be preaching a time prophecy though he claimed he wasn't. Mark Finley, Doug Batchelor and Stephen Bohr came out publicly and strongly against this doctrine. Though those three were right in what they said, in my opinion it is a bit ironic that three ministers who don't believe there is an infallible English Bible anywhere in the world would be the ones to put David Gates down. The afore mentioned sermon was downloaded to YouTube on 10/17/18 by David Gates and is titled “‘Even at the Door’ by Uncle David.” Brother Gate's prediction, which he said wasn't a prediction, didn't come to pass.

Next, brother Gates, who likes to be called “Uncle David,” opined that something momentous was going to happen in the spring of 2020. It appears that isn't going to happen. He is once again discussing time as a prophecy that he says isn't a prophecy whilst saying he thinks it's going to occur in the fall of 2020.

At 44:33 he says, “We didn't preach all the message of Daniel in 1843 to 1844.”

I saw that some were getting a false excitement, arising from preaching time, that the third angel's message can stand on its own foundation, and that it needs not time to strengthen it, and that it will go with mighty power, and do its work, and will be cut short in righteousness.” *Selected Messages Book One page 188.*

At 44:33 he says, “The literal time period we find in Daniel and Revelation must be declared to the world.”

At 45:26 he says, there is a past 2,520 prophetic years and a future literal 2,520 days.

At 48:17 he says, “We don't violate a Bible, a biblical principle by taking things exactly as it reads. Do you?” Yes David, in the case of prophecy you may violate a biblical principle when you take things exactly as they read.

At 49:06 he starts discussing “day zero” of the alleged literal 2,520 days. He says he doesn't know when it will start but thinks it will start in the fall of 2020. Day zero will be when the religious and secular powers unite to enforce environmental regulations and Sunday observance. That means whenever that occurs, there will be seven more years. Think about it, if that is true, a TIME PROPHECY will start at day zero.

Around 56:04 he starts discussing 1,260 literal days when Rome “will run the whole world” and he says at the end of the 1,260 days, “not a day later,” Rome's power will cease and probation will close and the plagues will be poured out over “45 days.”

So, Uncle David appears to be claiming that he isn't teaching a time prophecy when he is teaching a time prophecy. If you take his word for it, we have a minimum of 6.875 years

before probation closes. I personally wouldn't count on it being that long before probation closes.

“Should we advance in spiritual knowledge, we would see the truth developing and expanding in lines of which we have little dreamed, but it will never develop in any line that will lead us to imagine that we may know the times and seasons which the Father hath put in His own power. Again and again have I been warned in regard to time setting. There will never again be a message for the people of God that will be based on time.” *Selected Messages Book One page 188.*

“The Lord showed me that the message must go, and that it must not be hung on time; for time will never be a test again.” *Selected Messages Book One page 188.*

Notice that the Lord's Messenger did not say “prophetic time” nor did she say “literal time;” she said “time.”
